

Visit to Haji Ali Beach

The Zoology Department organised a field visit to Haji Ali Beach on 13th June 2017. Total 33 students of TYBSc Zoology along with 5 staff members participated in the field. The tour was accompanied by Mr. Pradeep Patade (Nature enthusiast) and Mr. Bhushan Bhior (Ex-PG Student) and Mr. Abhishek Satam (PhD Scholar). Students visited the Rock beach of Haji Ali and observed many marine organisms in their natural habitat such as, sponges, marine crabs, corals, flat worms, Brittle star, Pistol shrimp, Mussels, clams, oysters and many fish varieties. The students were intrigued to see the rich marine fauna in the beach within the city limit.

The students and teachers of the Zoology department visited on-board the exploratory fishery vessels, MatsyaNireekshani and MatsyaVrushti, during the open day organised by the Fishery Survey of India (FSI), Government of India on 05th July 2017. Total 22 students of the TYBSc Zoology class accompanied with 2 teachers participated the in the open day. The fisheries scientists of FSI explained the students the operations of various fishing gears and instruments used for fishery survey along the Indian EEZ such as bottom trawl, monofilament long lines, Purse-seining, Squid jigging, Echo-sounder, Radar, GPS, SONAR, etc.



Vertical Garden

Workshop on “Vertical Gardening” was held on 20th July 2017, organized by Zoology Department. Dr. Sheetal Pachpande (Meta designs Pvt. Ltd.) was the Expert. In the first session, S. Y. B. Sc. and T. Y. B.Sc. students were informed about various indoor plant varieties (shade loving plants) and their usefulness in means of both health and aesthetic value. During second session students were trained to convert waste bottles into a plant holders, using mixture of cocopeat, soil and organic manure. Additional sessions were held by T. Y. B.Sc. students for other students, to prepare their own ladder of plants and adopting for further care. The beautifully prepared ladders were hung up in the way to college library.
