Summary:

Teachers' feedback on syllabus of Economics covered at BA and Bcom levels suggests 100.00 per cent employability is offered by the subject. They believed into skill development traits of the syllabus and latest events coverage with 50.00 per cent considering it as excellent and rest as good. With respect to quality, clarity and relevance of textual reading/ Reference material/ Study material, both teachers were satisfied. When asked about the role of the syllabus taught at ARTS and Commerce levels to generate interest among students to pursue higher education, relevance of the learning objectives of the syllabus, weightage given to learning values (in terms of knowledge, concepts, manual skills, analytical abilities and broadening perspectives) and how is optimization of course content achieved, all teachers responded excellent. Report of the Analysis of Curriculum feedback from Students And Teachers

A google form survey was conducted by the department of Statistics to obtain a feedback on the curriculum offered at the First year B Sc course. A total of 8 responses were obtained for the same including the students from Second and third year.

Some findings are as follows:

- 1. 87.5 % of the students feel that the syllabus is excellent.
- 2. 50 % of the students say that the curriculum should be more application based.
- 3. According to one student the Statistical language is confusing. Rather simple English can be used.
- 4. Overall 75 % of the students have rated the curriculum as excellent.

Teacher feedback

As per teacher the syllabus must be more Application based. It should include small project or field work based on theoretical concepts. The curriculum should be designed to motivate students to pursue the subject at higher level.

The Zoology Department of M.D. College has collated all the feedbacks from our stakeholders, i.e., Students, Alumni, Employer's and Teachers. Below are their suggestions and recommendations:

Feedback from Teachers:-

- 1. In the UG syllabus, some of the topics are extensive and can be reduced a bit so that students can find it easy and enjoyable.
- 2. Topics such as Animal Biotechnology can be included in the SYBSc syllabus and not in the FYBSc syllabus.
- 3. The syllabus for Bioinformatics of the TYBSc can be reduced further, as it is difficult for the students to understand.
- 4. The MSc part-II syllabus encompases all the fundamental aspects of Oceanography and Fishery Science and also includes dissertation.
- 5. Dissections of the easily available invertebrate specimens can be included in the T.Y.B.Sc. and M.Sc-I practicals to study animal type studies
- 6. to include practical more with respect to animal study.

Feedback from Employers:-

Dr. Goldin Quadros, Principal Scientist & Head, Wetland Ecology Division, Salim Ali Centre for Ornihology and Natural History (SACON), Anaikatti P O, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu-

I have gone through the syllabus and must give credit to the entire team for producing an extensive syllabus. I find the FYBSc and M.SC II syllabus well balanced with proper justification to the subject and learning for the students. I find the syllabus for the S.Y. B.Sc, T.Y.B.Sc and the M.SC I a bit too crammed with all elements incorporated. Although it is good to have students learn about all aspects in todays time. It actually takes away the joy of learning from the students. I would suggest that some of the topics be included in a phased manner and focus on what would be essential for the students to absolutely gain knowledge.

You can feel free to take my suggestion although I certainly like the syllabus that sort of introduces the students to every aspects of modern and traditional conventional zoology.

Feedback from Alumni:-

- Some topics need a deeper input while some don't. And that's not properly designed. Some topics are repeated in every year's syllabus (for eg. The topic of mud crab in MSc). Also practical syllabus need to be modified as per the requirement of the job that students may pursue in future (for eg. Instrumentations techniques of various important on field instruments) some practicals that require only basic knowledge to perform can be eliminated (for eg. Making cottage cheese, moisture content, etc)
- To have topics encouraging entrepreneur.
- For students create some good research project, Nature Conservation activities.
- Curriculum must be more relevant to the upcoming market opportunities
- It should be more focused on practicals and/or field works
- I feel the oceanography part is less as compared to applied fishery part in the M.Sc syllabus. Detailed Oceanography from research point of view is required as we are giving oceanography and fishery technology degree.
- If possible latest topics in the field of virology, forensic science, nutrition can be mentioned.
- More of learner centered design.

Suggestions for improvement in the present curriculum by students:-

- Include more topics related to wildlife biology
- Include more Practicals.
- Giving assignments to students.
- Should focus more on practical learning than theoretical learning. Also include a subject in which the students get guided with career and scope ahead in detail.

Employers:

- Syllabus Should include learning of new technologies which are on going in IT sector. Giving more exposure to practical knowledge and hands on ,rather than just theoretical knowledge.
- Must include Cloud learning, azure, machine Learning, BI tools, database language, salesforce, bigdata, hadoop etc.






Difficulty level of course content 269 responses










Weightage given to Entrepreneurship






Difficulty level of course content




Relevance of Course outcomes 6 responses





