## Report on Online Workshop on 'E-content Development (Educational Audio-Video Production)' 10<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> May 2020

The global Covid-19 pandemic necessitates teachers to imbibe necessary skills for online teaching and learning requiring development of effective educational E-contents. To augment the online teaching skills of teachers, Maharshi Dayanand College organized 8 days online National workshop on "E-content Development (Educational Audio-Video Production)" from 10<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> May 2020. This online workshop was organized in collaboration with 'Maha-Bridge' and conducted by expert orators Mr. Bhushan Kulkarni and Mr. Eknath Kore. The online workshop was inaugurated by Shri. Uday Samant, Hon'ble Minister of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Maharashtra; Prof. Suhas Pednekar, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, University of Mumbai and Prof. Aniruddha B. Pandit, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Institute of Chemical Technology, Mumbai. Eminent personalities from all walks of the higher and technical education sector addressed the participants in the online National workshop, namely Dr. Sanjay Jagtap, Joint Director-Higher Education Panvel region; Dr. Yuvraj S. Malghe, Joint Director-Higher education, Mumbai region; and Dr. Manisha Kayande, MLC, Government of Maharashtra. The online workshop was attended by 100 in-house participants and 200 participants from different colleges across different districts in Maharashtra and other states of India including Madhya Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Haryana, karnataka and Odisha.





## Report on Online Workshop on "Experiential Teaching with Diverse Tools", 26<sup>th</sup> -27<sup>th</sup> May, 2020

A two day online workshop on "Experiential Teaching with Diverse Tools" was organised by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Maharshi Dayanand College of Arts, Science and Commerce on 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2020. Dr. Sampada Ketkar a renowned trainer for Experiential Teaching was the resource person for the workshop. Today technology has given teachers across the world a number of tools to enhance teaching methods. This workshop aimed to train teachers about using diverse teaching tools for making the teaching-learning process interesting and effective.

The workshop began with the welcome and introductory address by Principal Dr. Chhaya S. Panse. She pointed out the importance of e-learning in the present scenario. She also emphasised on the need for teachers to learn the diverse teaching tools and use dynamic multimedia content to make teaching-learning more innovative and effective. The first day program of the workshop was compered by Ms. Shubhda Gala, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Commerce. The second day program of the workshop was compered by Dr. Varsha Thorat, Associate Professor, Dept. of Chemistry. Vice Principal, Commerce Prof. S. Pathak proposed the vote of thanks.

According to Dr. Sampada Ketkar experiential education combines direct experience with focused reflection; builds on past knowledge and experiences; requires active involvement in meaning construction and encourages collaboration and exchange of ideas and perspectives. The participants learnt how to use different apps like Open shot, Film Maker, Plotagon, Online test portal, Padlets, Videoscribe, Comica, Storyboard That etc. These apps can be used for student-centred learning; to facilitate communication, collaboration, critical thinking, and creativity; to make presentation interesting for students and to give personalised feedback. She also discussed about few more very good apps for teachers like –Jamboard, Flipgrid, Whiteboard.Gr, Classroomscreen, Quizizz, Kahoot etc. These tools can be used in teaching, getting student feedback and evaluation.

This online workshop was attended by 294 (199 outside and 95 in-house) participants. It was very much appreciated by the participants.
