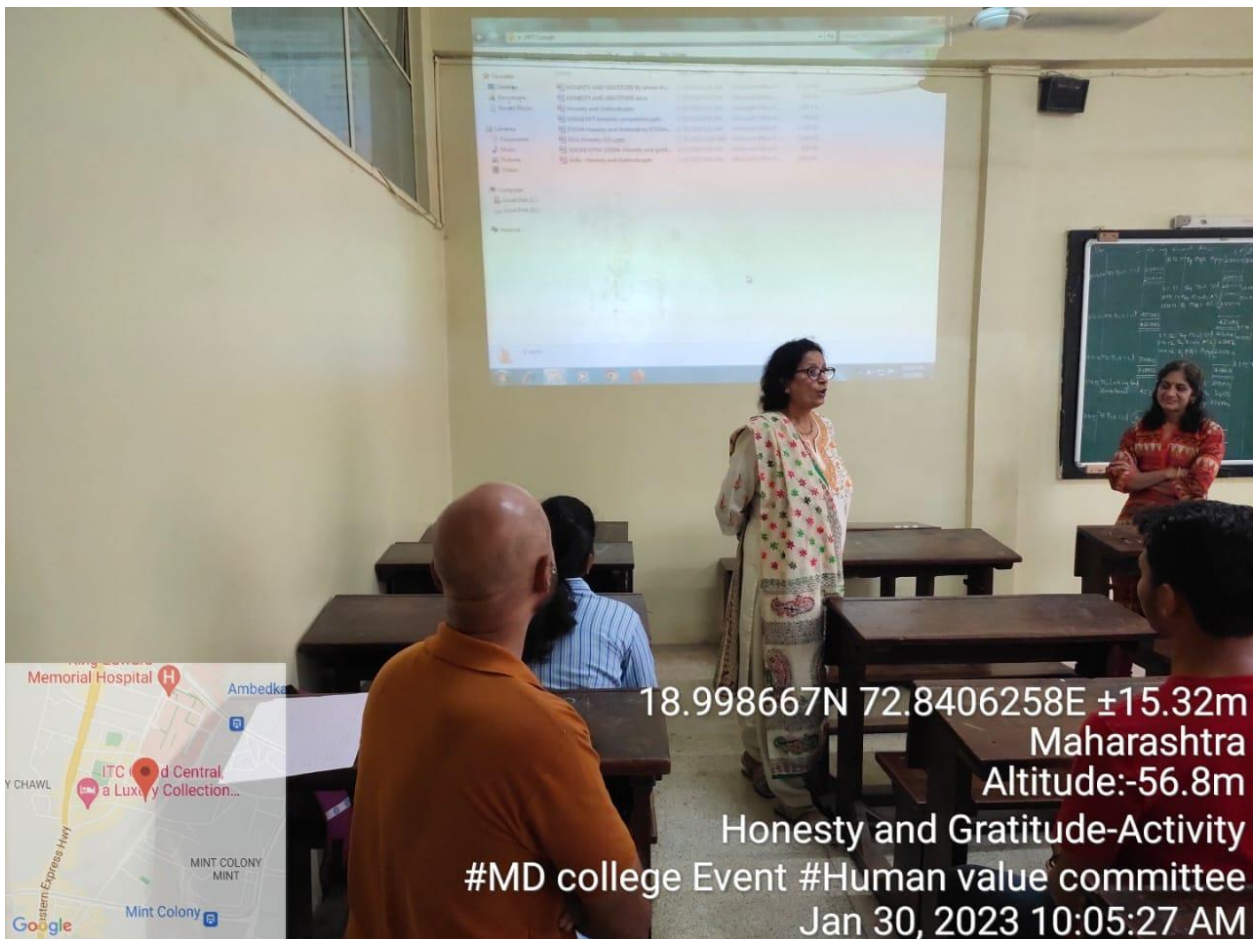


## Report of Event by Human Values Committee

- "Honesty is the best policy."

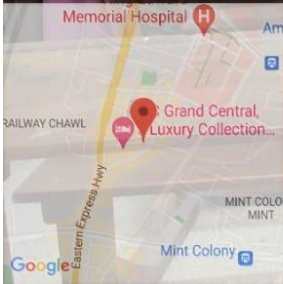
